# CALAIS/DOVER: A MINI-CRUISE TO THE UK

## The Port Boulogne Calais is the leading port in France for passenger traffic and second largest in Europe.

Each year it welcomes more than 10 million passengers who choose to transit through the port closest to the UK. Calais is a fast, flexible port, with services available 24/7, all year round. The port is located less than three hours from Paris, London and Brussels, and is connected to several motorways (A16, A26 and A25 in France, M20 and M2 in the UK) and railways criss-crossing Europe.

Two ferry companies offer up to fifty departures each day to Dover aboard spacious and comfortable ferries. The mini cruise takes about 75 minutes.

- A passenger information system is available to inform passengers in real time about the traffic situation and suggest alternative routes if needed as well as the departure times of ferries.
- The port provides a wide range of services including catering, toilets, nursery, phones, Wi-Fi, currency exchange, parking lots, drop-off ...
- The Calais site has 3 à la carte parking lots reserved for passenger vehicles.

### **CRUISES**



The Port Boulogne Calais welcomes cruise ships en route to the North Sea and the Baltic Sea.

In Calais, the vessels call at the deep-water quay of the Ravisse Basin. The port of Calais is also the bridgehead of the «Croisières de France» shipping line which sails to the Norwegian fjords from May to September.

At Boulogne-sur-Mer, ships calling at the port berth at the Quai de l'Europe (in deep water).

- The high level of security is ensured by checkpoints in both ports.
- Reception facilities are provided for cruise passengers.
