



FERRY TERMINAL FREIGHT

The ferry terminal receives both accompanied and unaccompanied freight traffic transshipping on double-deck ferries.

- 10 vessels
- 50 departures /day
- 24h /7d

The terminal at the Port of Calais is operated by the vessels of the P&O Ferries, DFDS and Irish Ferries shipping companies. 10 vessels operate on the Calais-Dover line, offering **up to 50 crossings in each direction, 24/7.**

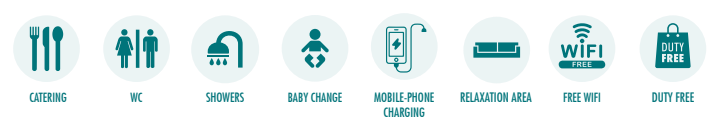


MARINE FACILITIES

The Port of Calais ferry terminal has **eight berths, equipped with double-deck linkspans** to facilitate the simultaneous loading/unloading of two ship decks. These linkspans can accommodate vessels of up to 240 m on the three linkspans of the new port (Calais 2) and 213 m on the five linkspans of the historic port (Calais 1). The operational capacity of double-deck ferry vessels **guarantees five rotations per vessel**, offering an unparalleled daily transport capacity to the UK.

DRIVER-RECEPTION FACILITIES

The **Le Calais building** in the new terminal, along with the **four service points** in the historic port, offer toilet blocks (toilets and showers), hot-drink and snack vending machines and more. Drivers can also access the duty-free shop in the new port. **Free Wi-Fi.**



CHECKS AND RECORDS

EXPORT: A series of documentary checks and vehicle inspections is carried out before access to boarding, by the various competent authorities.
IMPORT: A border-control system has been put in place upon entry to the EU. This is carried out by the customs brokers, the French customs authority and the Veterinary and Phytosanitary Inspection Service.

GOODS BORDER CROSSING 24 hours a day, 7 days a week

The ports of Calais and Boulogne remain accessible for goods 24 hours a day, seven days a week. Together, the agents of the customs authority, the Veterinary and Phytosanitary Inspection Service, Port Boulogne Calais and customs brokers assisted by on-site shipping agents **ensure the reliable passage of goods, both day and night.**

The Port of Calais provides its free **e-Border Calais Port** digital tool to coordinate all parties involved in the necessary checks, in order to ensure a better quality of service.
