The Port Boulogne Calais is a pan-European benchmark for the management of controlled-temperature logistics.

The port of Boulogne-sur-Mer is **THE hub for receiving and shipping** fish in Europe. It is served by all of the major European carriers, and most French carriers of refrigerated fish have their own platforms in it.

300,000 tonnes of fish and seafood are imported to Boulogne-sur-Mer each year from around the world and especially from the countries in northern Europe, including Denmark, Iceland, Ireland, Netherlands and Norway... and then redistributed throughout France and on to Spain and Italy.

Through its Seafood road terminal linked to transport platforms, Boulogne-sur-Mer provides an exemplary supply and distribution logistics service.

Thanks to these optimal conditions, the site ensures smooth and efficient logistics.

WAREHOUSING

The port of Boulogne-sur-Mer has an estimated controlled-temperature storage capacity of 300,000 m³ enabling the warehousing of some 65,000 pallets.

Some warehouses are placed under customs control.

Transit operations take place on a 24/7 basis.
